


BREYNA

- If you want to reach your camper's counselor during the camp day, call the office at 215-598-7143 and we will gladly relay your message. - Early and Late Care is available from 7:30 am—6:00 pm sharp. Please call the office if you will need this service.
- While it never rains at Briarwood, in the event of a passing shower, please send your camper with the appropriate rain gear should the forecast call for rain.
- Everyone should apply sunscreen daily prior to coming to camp.
